
Policy for Students' Accommodation in the University Hostels from the Academic Year-2022/2023 onwards

The University of Vavuniya has Hostel Facilities for 400 Male Students and 600 Female students at Pambaimadu, Vavuniya, Sri Lanka.

1. University annually gives priority to provide accommodation to all the first-year students from outstations. Out station is defined to be 25 Km away from the University. However, the availability of internal public transport facilities shall be considered in the case of residences within the 25 Km from the University.
2. Differently able students recommended by the Director/Support Centre for Persons with Disabilities.
3. Students on reasonable medical grounds recommended by the University Medical Officer.
4. Students who are facing dire financial difficulties with sufficient evidences on the recommendation of the Grama Niladhari (GS), Divisional Secretary (DS), Faculty Student Counsellor, Dean of the Faculty and Senior student Counsellor. Students under this category shall apply within the first month of the second semester of the current year to obtain accommodation in the University Hostels from the first semester of the forthcoming academic year.
5. No students with the history of ragging/bullying/unruly behavior shall be provided accommodation in the University Hostel under any circumstances.
6. The above policy shall be implemented from the academic year 2022/2023 onwards.

The above policy was approved by the Council of the University at its 25th meeting held on 28.10.2023.
