Certificate in Sign Language – 2025 /2026

The Certificate in Sign Language programme is initiated by the Support Centre for Persons with Disabilities and conducted through the Centre for Distance and Continuing Education, University of Vavuniya. Applications are invited from suitably qualified individuals for the Certificate in Sign Language (SLQF-1), a three-month programme conducted during weekends.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. For the people categorized under 'Target Group' other than the persons with disabilities: Candidates with the age of 17 years or above and shall be required to have completed Grade 9 in the secondary level of education.
2. For the persons with disabilities: Candidates with the age of 17 years or above and shall be required to have completed the primary education.

No prior knowledge of sign language is required. No selection test will be required. However, the university shall have the power to conduct interviews for applicants to ensure eligibility, if necessary.

Course Duration:

Three months (Part-Time) (**Lecturers will be conducted in weekends and public holidays.**)

Registration Fee – Rs. 1000/-

Course Fee – Rs. 14,000/-

Venue – University of Vavuniya, Park Road, Vavuniya.
